

Correct and Incorrect Depths



Correct At same depth or 1/2" deeper than seedling grew in nursery.



Incorrect Too deep and roots bent.



Incorrect Too shallow and roots exposed.



Tree Planting and Storage Guidelines






Figure 2: An example of the hole and shovel method of planting seedlings.







One method of long-term tree storage is the Fig. 3. "heeling-in" technique. Roots must be packed tightly in soil and kept moist, and the heel-in trench must be shaded and protected from the wind.




Fig. 4. Drawings 1 through 11 illustrate various ways that trees should not be planted. The ideal planting is shown in drawing 12.
